





3. Remove M10 flanged lock nut (B) and handle from shift lever.

4. Remove four expansion fasteners (A) securing tunnel cover. Remove cover.

- 5. Remove M8 nut (B) securing control lever housing.
- 6. Position control levers as required and remove lever housing.


Installation:

Installation is the reverse of removal.

Battery Removal and Installation

Removal:

- 1. Park machine safely. See "Park Machine Safely" in the Safety section.
- 2. Raise passenger seat.

- Disconnect all black negative cables (A) from battery first.
- 4. Slide back rubber protective cover (B) and disconnect all red positive cables.
- 5. Loosen hardware (C) that secures battery hold-down (D) and pivot hold-down away from battery.
- 6. Lift battery from vehicle.


Installation:

- 1. Install battery into vehicle with negative (-) terminal positioned toward front of vehicle and the battery seated properly in the battery tray.
- 2. Pivot battery hold-down firmly against battery and tighten retaining hardware to secure.
- 3. Connect all red positive cables to positive (+) battery terminal first. Tighten the connections.
- 4. Connect all black negative cables to negative (-) battery terminal. Tighten the connections.
- 5. Apply general purpose grease or silicone spray to battery terminals to help prevent corrosion.
- 6. Slide protective cover down the battery positive cable and seat it over the positive (+) terminal.

Fuel Tank Removal and Installation


- 1. Park machine safely. See "Park Machine Safely" in the Safety section.
- 2. Remove seat base cover. See "Seat Base Cover Removal and Installation" on page 384.

- 3. Remove occupant protective structure (OPS) (A). See "Occupant Protective Structure (OPS) Removal and Installation" on page 373.
- 4. Remove seat base cover (B). See "Seat Base Cover Removal and Installation" on page 384.

Note: Observe routing of fuel lines for reassembly.

5. Remove bolt (C) from fuel tank retaining bracket (D). Remove bracket.



Caution: Avoid Injury! Diesel fuel is explosive. Do not expose to open flame or spark. Serious injury can result. Store in a proper container. Wipe up any spills immediately.

- 6. Disconnect fuel lines to tank by compressing spring clamps (E). Plug fuel lines to prevent spills.
- 7. Remove fuel tank by lifting from machine.

Installation:

Installation is in the reverse of removal.

Cargo Box Removal and Installation


Removal:

1. Park machine safely on a level surface. See "Park Machine Safely" in the Safety section.

- 2. Raise cargo box.
 - a. Turn start switch (A) to RUN position.
 - b. Press cargo box lift switch (B) until lift limit is reached.
 - c. Turn start switch to OFF position.

- 3. Separate wire harness connectors (C) for rear lighting if installed.
- 4. Remove spring lock pin (D) from lift cylinder pin.
- 5. Hold cargo box in raised position and remove pin from lift cylinder.
- 6. Rotate lift cylinder forward to rest on transaxle.
- 7. Lower cargo box to rest on machine frame.
