

Replacing Bucket Teeth—TK Series

1. IMPORTANT:

Prevent machine damage. Check bucket teeth periodically so that wear does not extend to the bucket tooth shank.



TX1150806-UN: Pin



TX1150895-UN: Rubber Lock

LEGEND:

1 - Pin

2 - Rubber Lock (2 used)

Remove pin (1) by rotating counterclockwise 180° using a ratchet and socket.

- 2. Remove tooth.
- 3. Inspect pin and rubber locks (2) for damage. Replace if necessary.
- 4. Position the new tooth over the tooth shank.
- 5. Install pin by rotating clockwise 180°. Install pin in same orientation as removed. Check alignment of pin.

Removing the Bucket

- 1. Lower bucket to the ground.
- 2. Remove retainer cap screws and retainers.
- 3. Slide O-ring seals out of way. Remove bucket pins.
- 4. Install and adjust bucket to arm joist with proper shims as required.
