

Remove the hydraulic actuator and check the following:

- Check the movement of the rod and piston, making sure they easily slide in the cylinder bore for the full stroke of the cylinder.
- Examine the rod for roughness and scoring; it should be smooth.
- · Check actuator mounting points for signs of visible damage.

Action:

- Inspect the supply and return lines to the control valve.
